KNOW YOUR RIGHTS: TIME OFF TO VOTE
ON TUESDAY NOV.4TH, 2008



SUMMARY OF NEBRASKA LAW

Employees who do not have 2 consecutive hours when not required to be at work during polling hours are entitled to up to 2 paid hours leave to vote. Pay cannot be deducted if the employee gives notice in advance of Election Day.

The employer can set the time for leave to vote.
